## BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING FOR THE AWARD FOR PROCUREMENT OF PROCUREMENT OF VARIOUS PLANTING MATERIALS (A34)

## Resolution No. 167-2021 Series of 2021

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture Caraga Region had published an Invitation to Bid in the websites www.da.caraga.gov.ph and www.philgeps.net last December 5, 2020 and posted in the Bulletin Board of this office continuously for 7 calendar days for the procurement of Various Planting Materials under the SAAD Program grouped into three (3) Lots:

Lot 1-30,000 pieces Abaca Planting Materials (Suckers) Lot 2-29,550 Abaca Planting Materials (Seed Pieces)

1,050,000.00 738,750.00 230,400.00

Lot 3-5,760 pcs pieces Planting Materials (Banana-Lakatan)

WHEREAS, an opening of bids was conducted last December 28, 2020 at the DA Conference Room as scheduled and the BAC had declared Ernie Agroforest Nursery, Fruitful Enterprises and St. Padre Pios Garden's bid as "passed" during the preliminary examination of bids;

WHEREAS, upon deliberation of the detailed evaluation, the BAC declared the bid of Ernie Agroforest Nursery for Lot1 and Lot2 as the Lowest Calculated Bid while St. Padre Pios Garden's bid for Lot 3 as a single calculated bid and both were subjected to post qualification;

WHEREAS, the BAC and the TWG conducted the post qualification to determine the authenticity of the submitted documents and to determine its capacity to supply the contract if awarded;

WHEREAS, upon final deliberation conducted by the BAC members on March 15, 2021, it was found out that Ernie Agroforest Nursery had passed the post qualification requirements and was considered the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for Lot 1, however, its bid for Lot 2 was disqualified due to no available stocks;

WHEREAS, St. Padre Pios Garden had passed the post qualification requirements and considered a Single Calculated and Responsive Bid for Lot 3;

WHEREAS, the next lowest bid for Lot2 submitted by Fruitful Enterprises and St. Padre Pios Garden, were considered, however upon deliberation of the post-qualification report, it was found out that both bidders cannot provide the required post qualification documents to show its capability to supply the contract, hence declared disqualified;

NOW THEREFORE, in order to promote economy and efficiency, the BAC recommends to the Head of Procuring Entity, Abel James I. Monteagudo to award the procurement of Lot 1- 30,000 pieces Abaca Planting Materials (Suckers) to Ernie Agroforest Nursery; while Lot 3-5,760 pcs pieces Planting Materials (Banana-Lakatan) to St. Padre Pios Garden as the bid were considered as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid and a Single Calculated and Responsive Bid, respectively;

FURTHERMORE, the BAC recommends that Lot 2- 29,550 Abaca Planting Materials (Seed Pieces) be declared failure and to be procured thru Small Value Procurement to fast tract the procurement process;
