WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture Caraga Region had published an Invitation to Bid in the websites [www.da.caraga.gov.ph](http://www.da.caraga.gov.ph) and [www.philgeps.net](http://www.philgeps.net) last June 3, 2021 and posted on the Bulletin Board of this office continuously for 7 calendar days for the Procurement of Inorganic Fertilizers under SAAD Program-GAA 2021 with a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of P5,762,700.00 and grouped into two (2) lots as follows:

<b>Lot 1- 630 bags Controlled Release Fertilizer</b>	<b>P4,347,000.00</b>
<b>Lot 2- 1,287 bags Complete Fertilizer</b>	<b>P1,415,700.00</b>

WHEREAS, a pre-bid conference was held virtually through <https://meet.google.com/tzv-eytf-rge> last June 10, 2021 as scheduled;

WHEREAS, an opening of bids was conducted on June 23, 2021, 9:15 A. M. at the DA Conference Hall, Department of Agriculture Caraga Region, Capitol Site, Butuan City as scheduled;

WHEREAS, there was only one (1) bidder who bought and submitted its bid, namely Allied Botanical Corporation;

WHEREAS, upon opening of the bids, the BAC members examined the submitted technical component of Allied Botanical Corporation to verify the presence or absence of the required documents and was rated as "passed";

WHEREAS, the financial component of Allied Botanical Corporation was opened and read as indicated on the abstract of bids which is subject to a detailed bid evaluation;
