**RESOLUTION DECLARING FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE
PROCUREMENT OF 21,524 BAGS UREA (46-0-0) GRANULES (D2)**

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture Caraga Region had published an Invitation to Bid in the websites www.da.caraga.gov.ph and www.philgeps.net last March 27, 2021 and posted on the Bulletin Board of this office continuously for 7 calendar days for the Procurement of 21,524 bags Urea (46-0-0) Granules under Rice Program- GAA 2021 with a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Twenty One Million Five Hundred Twenty Four Thousand Pesos (P21,524,000.00)**;

WHEREAS, a pre-bid conference was held virtually through <https://meet.google.com/nvu-bfme-nfp> last April 5, 2021 as scheduled;

WHEREAS, an opening of bids was conducted on April 19, 2021, 9:15 A. M. at the DA Conference Hall, Department of Agriculture Caraga Region, Capitol Site, Butuan City as scheduled;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35.1(a) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA 9184), the Bids and Awards Committee shall declare a failure of bidding when No bids are received, among others;

NOW THEREFORE, the BAC recommends to the Head of Procuring Entity, Regional Executive Director, Abel James I. Monteagudo to declare failure of bidding for the Procurement of 21,524 bags Urea (46-0-0) Granules and to conduct review of the technical specifications, ABC and other terms and conditions of the contract before the conduct of another bidding process;
