**BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AWARD FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF  
14,500 LITERS LIQUID ZINC (A32)**

**Resolution No. 070-2022  
Series of 2022**

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture Caraga Region had published an Invitation to Bid in the websites [www.da.caraga.gov.ph](http://www.da.caraga.gov.ph) and [www.philgeps.net](http://www.philgeps.net) last November 5, 2021 and posted on the Bulletin Board of this office continuously for 7 calendar days for the Procurement of 14,500 Liters Liquid Zinc under the Rice Program- NEP 2021 with a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Eight Million Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 8,700,000.00)**;

WHEREAS, an opening of bids was conducted on November 29, 2021, 9:15 A. M. at the DA Conference Hall, Department of Agriculture Caraga Region, Capitol Site, Butuan City as scheduled and the BAC declared the bids of Jeels Masagana Farm Supply and Agrigrowth International Corporation as "passed" during the preliminary examination of bids;

WHEREAS, upon deliberation of the detailed bid evaluation conducted on December 10, 2021, the BAC determined that the bids submitted by Jeels Masagana Farm Supply as the Lowest Calculated Bid and qualified to undergo post qualification;

WHEREAS, the BAC together with the TWG conducted on January 10, 2022, an onsite post qualification to Jeels Masagana Farm Supply being the Lowest Calculated Bid to determine the authenticity of the submitted documents and its capability to supply the contract;

WHEREAS, upon final deliberation conducted by the BAC members on January 17, 2022, it was found out that Jeels Masagana Farm Supply had failed the post qualification requirements. It was found out that the offered product is not FPA Registered;

WHEREAS, the BAC decided that Agrigrowth International Corporation, having the next Lowest Calculated Bid, be subjected to a virtual post qualification on January 26, 2022 and found to have passed post qualification requirements, hence, considered the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid;


NOW THEREFORE, in order to promote economy and efficiency, the BAC recommends to the Head of Procuring Entity, Ricardo M. Oñate Jr., to award the Procurement of 14,500 Liters Liquid Zinc to Agrigrowth International Corporation as its bid was considered the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid.
