



RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE PROCUREMENT OF 7,468 LITERS LIQUID ZINC AND 7,468 LITERS 3N1 BIO-CONTROL AGENT THRU NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-EMERGENCY PURCHASES

Resolution No. 329-2022

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture-Regional Office Caraga intends to purchase 7,468 Liters Liquid Zinc and 7,468 Liters 3n1 Bio-Control Agent for Bacteria, Fungi and Virus Control through the Rice Program with an ABC of Eleven Million Two Hundred Two Thousand Pesos (₱ 11,202,000.00) under the Quick Response Fund (QRF TD Agaton) grouped as follows;

Lot 1- 7,468 liters Liquid Zinc

Lot 2- 7,468 liters Bio-Control Agent for Bacteria, Fungi and Virus Control

WHEREAS, the said production inputs are aimed to help the farmers to recover from the devastated effects of Typhoon Agaton and enable them to rehabilitate their farms as soon as possible;

WHEREAS, there is a need to procure these inputs the soonest time possible to provide immediate response to the affected farmers for them to regain their farm losses;

WHEREAS, Section 53.2 of the latest Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 provides for the Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases maybe resorted to in cases of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or other causes where immediate action is necessary;

WHEREAS, the DA issued a memorandum dated February 3, 2022 to resort to Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases to expedite the procurement of various goods as immediate response to the farmers affected by typhoon and help them recover from their present state;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted the procurement activities using the Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases to fast track the procurement process;

WHEREAS, the BAC determined the suppliers who are legally, technically, and financially capable based on records and conducted post qualification to determine the supplier's capacity to supply the requirements of this office;

WHEREAS, there was only one (3) bidders that submitted its quotation, namely, Agrigrowth International Corporation, Ahcil Laboratories, Inc. and Lactobiotics Worldwide Corporation per Abstract of Quotations and said bid was subjected to post qualification;

WHEREAS, during the preliminary deliberation by the BAC, it was determined that the bid of Agrigrowth International Corporation the lowest calculated bid for lot 1.

WHEREAS, Lactobiotics Worldwide Corporation and Ahcil Laboratories, Inc. are the lowest calculated bid for Lot 2, however both bidders failed due to non conformity with the required specification, specifically on the required active ingredient. Hence, Agrigrowth International Corporation was declared Lowest Calculated Bid and subjected to post qualification for lots 1 and 2;

WHEREAS, upon final deliberation conducted by the BAC members on October 6, 2022, it was found out that Agrigrowth International Corporation had passed the post qualification requirements and was considered responsive to the required specifications, terms and conditions;

NOW THEREFORE, in order to promote economy and efficiency, the Bids and Awards Committee of this office hereby recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity, Engr. Ricardo M. Oñate, Jr. to award the procurement of 7,468 liters Liquid Zinc (Lot 1) and 7,468 liters Bio-Control Agent for Bacteria, Fungi and Virus Control (Lot 2) to Agrigrowth International Corporation for having the lowest calculated and responsive quotation;
