



**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE PROCUREMENT OF 1,000 LITERS ORGANIC PLANT SUPPLEMENT
THRU NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-EMERGENCY PURCHASES**

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture-Regional Office Caraga intends to purchase 1,000 liters Organic Plant Supplement through the Rice Program with an ABC of Seven Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Pesos (₱ 725,000.00) under the Quick Response Fund (QRF-TD Agaton);

WHEREAS, the said production inputs are aimed to help the farmers to recover from the devastated effects of Typhoon Agaton and enable them to rehabilitate their farms as soon as possible;

WHEREAS, there is a need to procure these inputs the soonest time possible to provide immediate response to the affected farmers for them to recover and regain their farm losses;

WHEREAS, Section 53.2 of the latest Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 provides for the Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases maybe resorted to in cases of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or other causes where immediate action is necessary;

WHEREAS, the DA issued a memorandum dated February 3, 2022 to resort to Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases to expedite the procurement of various goods as immediate response to the farmers affected by the typhoon and help them recover from their present state;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted the procurement activities using the Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases to fast tract the procurement process;

WHEREAS, the BAC determined the suppliers who are legally, technically, and financially capable based on records and conducted post qualification to determine the supplier's capacity to supply the requirements of this office;

WHEREAS, there were two (2) bidders that submitted its quotation, namely, Ahcil Laboratories, Inc. and Enviro Scope Synergy, Inc. per Abstract of Quotations;

WHEREAS, during the preliminary deliberation by the BAC, it was determined that the bid of Ahcil Laboratories, Inc. as the lowest calculated bid and was subjected to post qualification;

WHEREAS, upon deliberation conducted by the BAC members, it was found out that Ahcil Laboratories, Inc. failed the post qualification requirements due to invalid/unsigned documents submitted and other laboratory results failed to show the presence of the NPK content as one of the required specifications, hence, Ahcil Laboratories, Inc.' bid was declared disqualified;


WHEREAS, the BAC considered the other bid by Enviro Scope Synergy, Inc. which was found to be within the ABC of the project and was subjected to post qualification;

WHEREAS, upon final deliberation conducted by the BAC members, it was found out that Enviro Scope Synergy, Inc. had passed the post qualification requirements and was considered responsive to the required specifications, terms and conditions;


NOW THEREFORE, in order to promote economy and efficiency, the Bids and Awards Committee of this office hereby recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity, Engr. Ricardo M. Oñate, Jr. to award the procurement of 1,000 liters Organic Plant Supplement to Enviro Scope Synergy, Inc. for having the lowest calculated and responsive quotation;
