



**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE PROCUREMENT OF VARIOUS AGRICULTURAL INPUTS THRU  
NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-EMERGENCY PURCHASES**

Resolution No. 777-2022  
Series of 2022

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture-Regional Office Caraga intends to purchase various agricultural inputs through the Corn Program with a total ABC of Three Million Seven Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Pesos (₱ 3,795,000.00) under the Quick Response Fund (QRF TD Agaton) grouped into lots;

Lot 1 -230 bags Hybrid Corn Seeds- ₱ 1,380,000.00  
Lot 2 - 690 bags Complete Fertilizer - ₱ 2,070,000.00  
Lot 3 - 690 bags Organic Fertilizer (Granules)- ₱ 345,000.00

WHEREAS, the said production inputs are aimed to help the farmers to recover from the devastated effects of Typhoon Agaton and enable them to rehabilitate their farms as soon as possible;

WHEREAS, there is a need to procure these inputs the soonest time possible to provide immediate response to the affected farmers for them to replant and regain their farm losses;

WHEREAS, Section 53.2 of the latest Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 provides for the Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases maybe resorted to in cases of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or other causes where immediate action is necessary;

WHEREAS, the DA issued a memorandum dated February 3, 2022 to resort to Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases to expedite the procurement of various goods as immediate response to the farmers affected by the typhoon and help them recover from their present state;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted the procurement activities using the Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases to fast track the procurement process;

WHEREAS, the BAC determined the suppliers who are legally, technically, and financially capable based on records and conducted post qualification to determine the supplier's capacity to supply the requirements of this office;

WHEREAS, there were six (6) bidders that submitted its quotation, namely, Jeels Masagana Farm Supply, Inc., Jedeco Trading Corporation, Aktiv Multi Trading Co. Phils. Inc., Farmers Edge Agriventures, Inc., Modern Time Enterprises, Inc. and Roy Agribest Phils. Inc. per Abstract of Quotations;

WHEREAS, during the preliminary deliberation by the BAC, it was determined that the following bids were the lowest calculated bids and to be subjected to post qualification;

Lot 1 - Aktiv Muti Trading Co. Phils. Inc.  
Lot 2 - Jeels Masagana Farm Supply, Inc.  
Lot 3 - Roy Agribest Phils. Inc.

WHEREAS, upon final deliberation of the BAC conducted on October 6, 2022, it was found out that Jeels Masagana Farm Supply, Inc. had passed the post qualification requirements for Lot 2 and was recommended for award while Aktiv Muti Trading Co. Phils. Inc. for Lot 1 was for further evaluation and Roy Agribest Phils. Inc. for Lot 3 was required to submit the appropriate 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Certification;

WHEREAS, another round of final deliberation on October 17, 2022 was conducted and upon substantial discussion of the BAC on the post qualification results, it was found out that Aktiv Muti Trading Co. Phils. Inc. was compliant and had passed the post qualification requirements for Lot 1, hence recommended for award while Roy Agribest Phils. Inc. was still unable to submit the lacking required document for Lot 3;

WHEREAS, despite numerous follow ups made by the BAC Secretariat and the TWG, Roy Agribest Phils. Inc. was unable to submit the required appropriate 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Certification, hence, the BAC declared its bid as disqualified;

NOW THEREFORE, in order to promote economy and efficiency, the Bids and Awards Committee of this office hereby recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity, Engr. Ricardo M. Oñate, Jr. to award the procurement of Lot 1 -230 bags Hybrid Corn Seeds to Aktiv Muti Trading Co. Phils. Inc. and Lot 2 - 690 bags Complete Fertilizer to Jeels Masagana Farm Supply, Inc. for having lowest calculated and responsive quotation;


