RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF VEGETABLE SEEDS (C2)

Resolution No. 64-2020
 Series of 2020

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture Regional- Caraga had published an Invitation to Bid in the websites www.da.caraga.gov.ph and www.philgeps.net last May 12, 2020 and posted in the Bulletin Board of this office continuously for 7 calendar days for the Procurement on the Supply and Delivery of Vegetable Seeds under the Organic Agriculture Program which is grouped into lots:

- Lot 1 - Lowland Vegetable Seeds - Pinakbet
- Lot 2 - Upland Vegetable Seeds - Chopseuy
- Lot 3 - Fruit - Veges

WHEREAS, an opening of bids was conducted last June 1, 2020 at the DA Conference Room as scheduled;

WHEREAS, there were three (3) bidders that responded to the invitation namely, East West Seed Compay, Inc., SeedWorks Philippines, Inc. and Lumad sa Agdawan Farmers Multi-Purpose Cooperative (LAMPUFACO);

WHEREAS, upon opening of the bids on the scheduled place, date and time and upon evaluation by the BAC, it was found out that all bidders passed the eligibility and technical requirements;

WHEREAS, upon further evaluation of the submitted proposal and based on the deliberation conducted by the BAC members, the following were the findings:

- Lot 1 and 3 - East West Seed Compay, Inc.'s bid was disqualified due to an expired Tax clearance, hence, Seedworks' bid being the next lowest calculated bid was considered and was found to have complied with the technical requirements.
- Lot 2 - East West Seed Compay, Inc.'s bid was disqualified due to an expired Tax Clearance

WHEREAS, the BAC decided to forego the actual visit to conduct post qualification of bidders with the Lowest Calculated Bid due to the Presidential Proclamation No. 922 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines upon the recommendation of the DOH following the confirmed local transmission of the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) which prescribed travel restrictions;

WHEREAS, the BAC, however, determined the bidders' satisfactory previous performance with the agency in addition to the verification and authentication of submitted documents;


WHEREAS, upon final deliberation conducted by the BAC members, it was found that SeedWorks Philippines, Inc. passed the Post Qualification requirements and was considered the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for Lots 1 & 3;


NOW THEREFORE, in order to promote economy and efficiency, the BAC recommends to the Head of Procuring Entity, Abel James I. Monteagudo to award the procurement on the supply and delivery of Lot 1 - Lowland Vegetable Seeds and Lot 3 - Fruit-Veges to SeedWorks Philippines, Inc as their bid was considered the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid.

FURTHER, the BAC recommends that Lot 2 (Upland Vegetable Seeds - Chopseuy) be procured thru small value procurement.
