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## RICE FARM MECH/ EQUIPMENT/FACILITY

### ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS

- Registered Farmers' Organization (FO), Farmers' Association (FA), Farmers' Cooperative (FC), Irrigators' Association (IA), Agrarian Reform Beneficiaries Organization (ARBO), and other rural-based organizations.
- Agricultural schools, universities, and colleges.

### QUALIFICATIONS OF A CANDIDATE RECIPIENT

- Must have a concrete plan for the use of the requested machinery, equipment, and facilities for the benefit of its members
- Must have a service area or volume of production at least equivalent to the capacity of the requested machinery, equipment, and facilities
- Must be currently engaged in, but not limited to, production, processing, and marketing of palay/ rice, corn, high-value crops, livestock, and poultry, or any combination thereof;
- Must have an existing shed or willing to provide a shed with a design appropriate for the safe storage of the machinery and/ or equipment being requested;
- Must have the technical, financial, and institutional capacity to operate and maintain the machinery, equipment, and facilities to be received;
- Must have an operator capable of operating and maintaining the requested machinery, equipment, and facilities. The operator must be willing to undergo the appropriate National Certificate training course(s); and
- **Must be willing to undergo further training course(s).**

- Letter of Intent
- MAO/CAO/PAO Endorsement
- Photos of existing shed/ Proof of availability of land
- Proof of conditional deed of donation/sale
- Map of the Service area
- Utilization Area
- Certificate of registration CDA/SEC/DOLE/DSWD/DAR/NCIP
- FA/FO/IA/RBO Profile
- Utilization Proposal

### RICE RESILIENCY PROJECT (RRP) II

- Aims to increase farmer's productivity and ensure food security through the provision of free seeds and fertilizer subsidy.
- 3 Sub-Projects: Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund (RCEF) Enhanced, Expanded Inbred Rice Production (Beyond RCEF Areas), Expanded Hybrid Rice Production in Suitable Areas

### HOW TO AVAIL (SEEDS DISTRIBUTION)?

- Registry System for Basic Sector for Agriculture (RSBSA) - registered

### HOW TO AVAIL (FERTILIZER COMPONENT)?

- 2 bags/hectare for inbred
- 3 bags/hectare for hybrid
- Municipal/City Agriculturist prepares the masterlist of eligible farmer-beneficiaries
